#### How and where will I study?

Along with enrichment trips to build confidence and team skills. Learners may be required to complete additional tasks outside of the classroom as part of their course.

What are the entry requirements? You will need four GCSEs at grade 3 or above.

#### How will I be assessed?

You will carry out both written and practical tasks and be provided with developmental feedback to aid your progression. There are two units which are examination based and externally assessed, you will be able to draw upon your previous learning and experience for these examinations.

#### **Progression and careers:**

Progression to the Level 3 Award or Certificate in Business is an ideal pathway to further your skills and abilities in preparation for a career in a business environment. This course will give you the skills, knowledge and experience you need to gain the best start to progress to your future career. This could be within business administration and customer service roles in various industries, including: human resource administrative roles, records clerks and administrators, customer call desks, sales administrators, office supervisor and office management roles.
